It is intended for highly motivated students doing outstanding work in a given subject or medium who have already completed significant course work in the area/s of study they are designating. To take an independent study class, the student, in close consultation with the faculty member with whom they wish to study, must develop a proposal for a <u>rigorous</u> course of directed study including what the student wishes to accomplish and the number and length of faculty/student meetings.

No more than 4 units can be taken during any quarter. Units, however, are variable (i.e. 1-4 units not to exceed 4 units per quarter).

In order to receive course credit, complete this form, have it signed by the faculty member with whom you are studying, and submit it to the Art department office for the Chair's approval no later than the second week of classes in the quarter in which you wish to receive credit. This is in addition to adding the class in the Registrar's Office.
